Order of Service: Vespers: shortened version, but including congregational singing of the Gloria Patri and Psalm and ending with the Nunc Dimittus and Three fold Amen

Homily: "For You There Shall Be Songs, As On a Night Of Sacred Pilgrimage, Your Hearts Glad, as you Follow the Flute to the Holy Hill" (someplace in Isaiah,
